## FUNDING/GRANT BYLAWS

Provisions of the Bylaws shall not be in conflict with the BWC Safety Agreement.

### ARTICLE I. ~ AUTHORIZATION

Section I These by-laws are adopted by the Union County Executive Safety Council

To provide funding or grants for businesses to promote safety in the workplace.

### Article II. ~ PROCEDURE

Section II Requesting funding or grants from the Union County Safety Council.

- The Union County Executive Safety Council will consider funding a safety grant to a Union County business or government agencies or public outreach agencies that can communicate a Safety need that they cannot fully fund themselves.
- The business or agency seeking this funding must submit, in writing, the exact requirement, the amount requested and a justification in terms of the impact on the safety of their employees and/or others.
- The Executive Safety Council must receive this written requested by the end of each calendar year (December 31).
- The Union County Executive Safety Council will then meet at the regular monthly meeting to decide on which, if any, requirements meet our criteria and will be funded.
- The Council would then partially or fully fund the grant for money by check at a subsequent Union County Safety meeting.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned certifies that these By-Laws have been adopted this 12th day of MARCH, 2008, by the Union County Executive Safety Committee.
