PREVIOUS MEETING:

June 10, 2009: Transitional Work Programs

Summary: The goal of Transitional Work Programs (TWP) is to help bring injured employees back to work safely, timely and effectively. While preventative efforts, such as implementing a safety program, can help to ensure that injuries don't happen in the first place, it is important to establish a well-developed TWP early to enable quick reactions when injuries do occur.

Job Analyses are one of the key components to developing a TWP. They provide a functional description of each job task performed by your employees. First, each step of a work task is identified, then the physical demands, such as weights lifted, are described. These help to provide alternative work tasks that fit within the employee's work restrictions.

There are many agencies that can help develop a TWP for your company, such as your workers' compensation Third Party Administrator (TPA), Managed Care Organization (MCO), or even local disability service organizations. The outcomes of your program though should always be the same: control costs by keeping employees working, ensuring a positive return to work experience, maximizing work force potential and ensuring injured workers make a full recovery.
